EXHIBITORS:

ANKIROS – ANNOFER – TURKCAST 2008 Exhibitions were organized on an area of net 15,006 m², with the participation of 786 companies from 38 different countries and the total area covered by the exhibitions were 30,000 m². The distribution of exhibitors by their origin is as follows:

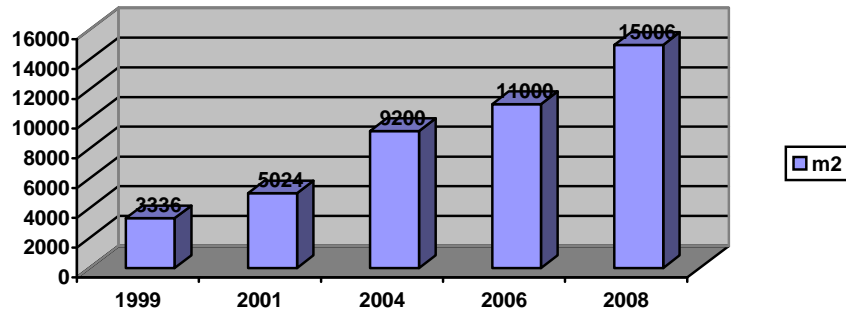

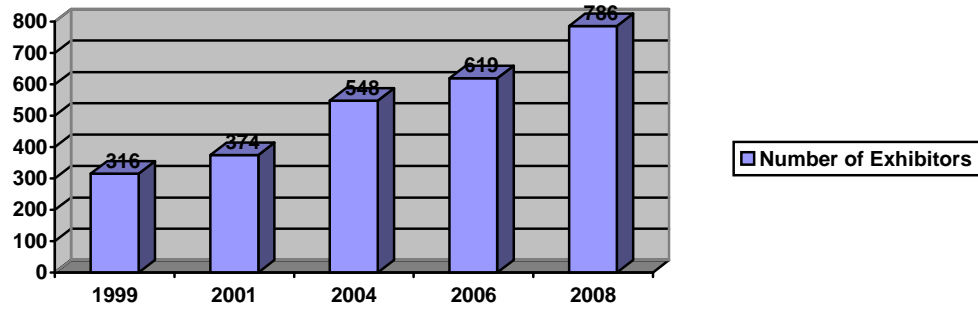

the success of the show with the opportunity to meet the right target customers, quality of the contacts made and the business concluded during the exhibition. According to this objective and success criteria:

96% of exhibitors rated the exhibition as being “very successful” and “successful”.

91% of exhibitors described the event as “fruitful”.

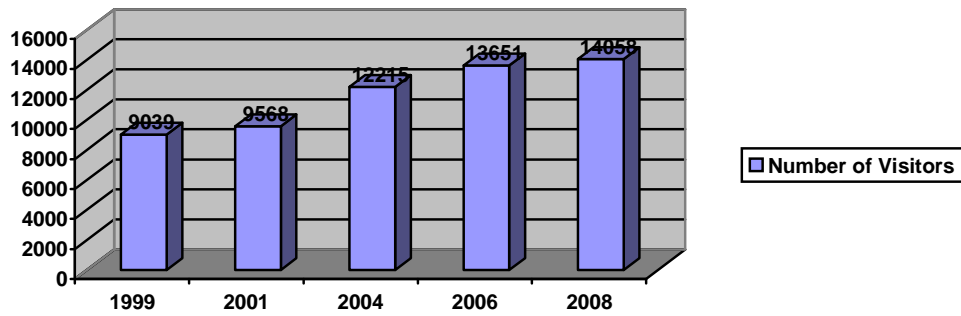

4. International Ankiros Foundry Congress
